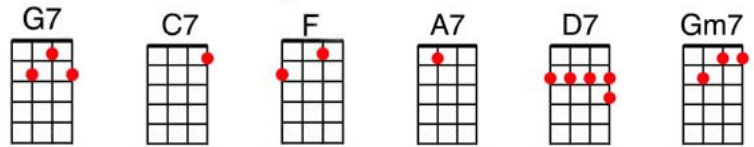


MY LITTLE GRASS SHACK IN KEALAKEKUA, HAWAII
